Complete 6 CEUs (60 hours) of continuing education from the current IAEM USA Training Allocation Table.		

- Recertification for NVEM-A and NVEM will be every five years
- Failure to recertify within five years of the last certification or recertification will result in temporary suspension of certification until requirements are met
- A lapse of more than seven years between the last certification or recertification will require reapplication to the certification program.
- Completion dates for requirements must fall after the last certification or recertification date.
- If unable to meet the full recertification requirements, an NVEM may recertify as an NVEM-A. The candidate may be reconsidered for NVEM if recertification requirements are met within one year.
